This first quarter of 2021 was a significant period for the GEFF Tajikistan Project and our Financial Partners. The GEFF Tajikistan credit line was re-activated with Bank Eskhata joining the program. A financing package of US\$ 4 million has been allocated to support green financing for private sector investing in green technology solutions. Households and small and medium-sized enterprises across the country, including in villages and remote rural areas, will benefit from Eskhata's loans for climate adaptation technologies and services, such as drip irrigation, rainwater harvesting and storage, sustainable land-management solutions, solar panels and energy-efficient cold-storage facilities. 
A total of 377 Eskhata Bank personnel in Dushanbe, Khatlon, Sugd and the Districts of Republican Subordination have been trained to improve their capacity in green financing. The GEFF Tajikistan Project Consultant also partners Bank Eskhata in the development and implementation of joint marketing activities to further promote green solutions.

The reactivation of the GEFF credit line in March 2021 enables beneficiaries like Mr Karimov to gain access to GEFF financing. Mr. Karimov applied for a GEFF loan and became the first GEFF Tajikistan sub-borrower in 2021. Mr. Karimov's investment in a new water system and 1400 meters of PVC pipes on a 6-hectare land will eventually reduce water loss & consumption, increase his income and provide the land with regular and stable water supply for the irrigation of crops.

We also launched the continuation of the GEFF Tajikistan Radio Interview series with Radio Station Vatan that has been well received in 2020. This allows us to continue outreach and awareness-raising activities despite restrictions imposed by the Covid-19 pandemic.

The outlook for GEFF Tajikistan in 2021 is a positive one, marked with various milestones and activities that will scale up green financing in Tajikistan. We would like to thank our partners for their support and look forward to partnering you in upcoming activities.

As a GEFF PFI, Bank Eskhata is able to on-lend to farmers and entrepreneurs investing in green technology solutions. Capacity building in the promotion and processing of GEFF Tajikistan eligible technologies by Eskhata Bank's personnel is one of the core objectives of the project. To achieve these goals, the Project Consultant team delivered introductory trainings to both the loan officers and credit managers of Eskhata Bank.

The trainers presented information on the GEFF project eligibility criteria, portfolio screening methods, green investment procedures and loan processing. It also equips loan officers with knowledge on target segments, sales and client acquisition techniques. Also, the verification procedures and incentives were discussed with the participants.

The launch of the GEFF project at Bank Eskhata in 2021 is a timely measure because of the high demand for green loans among the farmers and agribusiness.



GEFF Tajikistan has continued updating the <u>Green Technology Selector</u> (GTS) with more than 100 new vendors from all regions of Tajikistan with GEFF eligible technologies registered on the GTS during the first quarter of 2021. Thus, the number of Tajik vendors in the GTS has reached 163. There were 769 registered products in the GTS and the total number of products in the segment of Tajikistan was 1837.


Now, the GTS features popular products in Tajikistan such as pumps, greenhouses, home and display refrigerators,

air conditioners and washing machines amongst others.

It should also be noted that innovative products such as injection molding machines, extruders, sub-soilers, and notillage seeders have been added.
